

WATERFALL MAINTENANCE

Running water is the key to keeping water clean. That's why we recommend putting your *waterfall* on a timer, so that your waterfall will be running consistently on a daily basis.

- 1) Changing your water in your *waterfall* completely once a month is important. Why? Adding Chemicals does not effect the build up dust and debris that falls into your pond areas.
- 2) OASIS PRODUCTS, INC. sells 2 chemicals for keeping your *waterfall* clean.
FOUNTEC: Helps in preventing most forms of algae.
PROTEC: Helps keep mineral deposits from forming around water way areas.
- 3) When evaporation occurs, you will need to add water to your *waterfall*. This is important for two reasons. 1st, water evaporates naturally, because of this process adding fresh water to your waterfall will help keep water fresh and clean. 2nd, it's important also that the pump used for the waterfall be completely submerged in water at all times.
- 4) If *waterfall* is placed outdoors, where leaves and debris may fall into *waterfall*, then wrap pump with shade cloth screening material found at hardware stores. This will keep most debris from entering into your pump. It will also help eliminate foam bubbles.
- 5) **DO NOT ALLOW PUMP TO FREEZE.** Remove pump and water during freezing weather. If water freezes, it needs to thaw naturally without any physical force. Breaking frozen water on your *waterfall* could damage surface, and void warranty.
- 6) If *waterfall* has not been in operation for a period of time, you might find that the tubing will not allow the pump to pass water. If this happens use a garden hose water pressure to flush out any insect nests or any other obstructions.
- 7) When placing real rocks in and around *waterfall* be careful not to cause splatter or damming by rock position.
- 8) If your *waterfall* obtains algae, and you would like to remove it then follow these steps:
 - a) Remove water
 - b) Use a soft nylon brush and brush algae areas.
 - c) Rinse areas with your garden hose.
 - d) After *waterfall* is clean, place back where you had it, then fill with fresh water.
- 9) Waterfalls Indoors: **DO NOT PLACE WATERFALL** directly on wood, tile, or carpet surfaces, without putting a barrier material directly underneath for protection.
- 10) Although our *waterfall's* are designed for minimal splashing, some splashing may occur. You will want to keep this in mind when using indoors.

PUMP MAINTANCE

This is a magnet driven pump powered by a water tight motor. Every two months clean the side intake cover, the rotor assembly, and regulator discharge, delicately in warm water and vinegar.
